What is NaTIS?

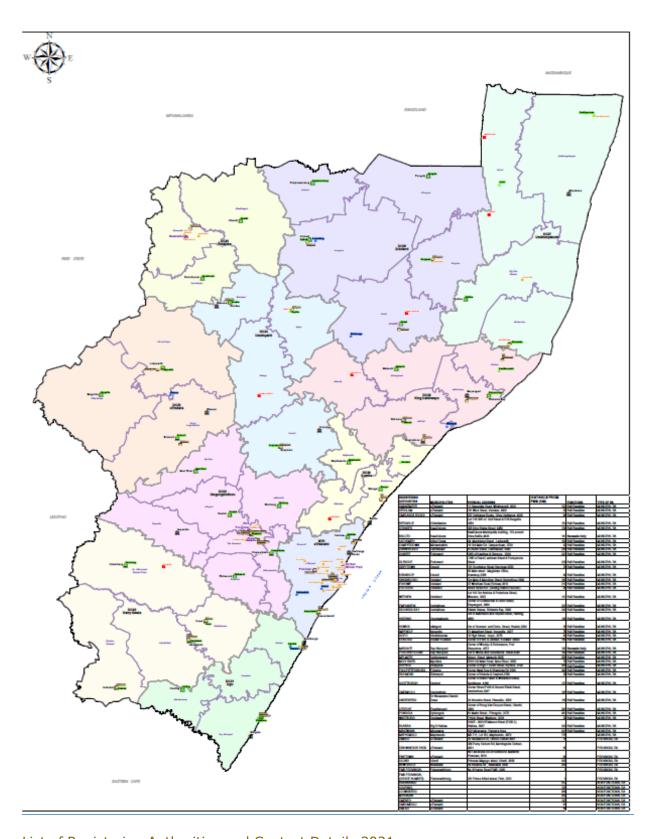
The National Traffic Information System (NaTIS) is used as a register that supports the National Road Traffic Act, 1996 (Act no. 93 of 1996) and Regulations. The custodian of the NaTIS is the Road Traffic Management Corporation (RTMC).

The NaTIS includes registers of the following:

- Motor vehicles.
- Vehicle manufacturers, importers and builders.
- Motor trade numbers.
- Temporary and special permits.
- Operators.
- Driving licences and professional driving permits.
- Infrastructure: authorised officers, instructors, driving licence testing centres, vehicle testing stations, examiners of vehicles and examiners of driving licences.
- Accidents.
- Contraventions.
- Vehicle fitness (roadworthiness).
