CELE TO FULFILL THE LONG AWAITED PROMISE TO IMPENDLE COMMUNITY

KWAZULU-NATAL MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Mr. Bheki Cele will on **Saturday (01 September 2007) at Nogasela Primary School, Impendle at 09h00** officiate the sod-turning of road P127.

The road is approximately 55 km long and its estimated cost is approximately R350 million which will spread over a period of five years. This road is expected to be upgraded from Impendle to Himeville and is said to be the first Black top project in this community.

Cele's commitment to this upgrade is subsequent to the promise made by the then Transport MEC S'bu Ndebele four years ago that the road would be upgraded and surfaced. The community of Impendle will witness this reality that is going to create job opportunities for them.

The upgrade of the road will improve access to the existing four clinics and twenty four (24) schools that are situated within the surrounding communities.
