TWELVE PEOPLE DIE AND THREE CRITICALLY INJURED ON THE N2 NEAR EMPANGENI

Twelve people died and three critically injured on a gruesome accident that took place on the

N2 near Enseleni Game Park at Empangeni today (28/09/08) at approximately 15h30.

It is alleged that an Isuzu bakkie without a canopy, carrying six passengers who died on the

scene, collided with a Ford bakkie that had a canopy and was carrying nine passengers of which

six died on the scene and three were critically injured. The critically injured were rushed to

Engwelezani hospital to receive medical attention. According to the RTI officer who attended

the scene of the accident, the Isuzu bakkie had smooth tires which were unroadworthy. Of the

twelve that died four were female adults, seven were male adults and one was a male child.

"I wish to send my deepest condolences to the families and friends of those who lost their lives

in such a gruesome way. I also wish to emphasize that road safety is everyone's responsibility;

therefore 100% compliance should be our way of life. It is every driver's responsibility to check

the roadworthiness of their vehicles before undertaking any trip. We will continue to enforce

the law on those who do not want to obey the rules of the road to prevent such accidents from

happening," said Cele.
