CELE TO ATTEND MASS FUNERAL OF EIGHT VICTIMS SAWOTI ACCIDENT VICTIMS

KwaZulu-Natal MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison Mr. Bheki Cele will on Sunday (02-03-08) attend the mass funeral of eight people killed in a horrific head on collision between a bus and a minibus taxi on the R612 between Breamer and Sawoti in the South Coast on Tuesday (26/0208).

The funeral is due to take place on Sunday at Jolivet Sports field near

Umzinto at 10 am. The accident took place when the driver of the bus was trying to overtake a car and consequently collided head on with an on coming minibus taxi which was traveling in an opposite direction. Upon impact eight people were killed instantly and two sustained serious injuries.
