## SWIFT MOVE BY POLICE IN ARRESTING FOUR PEOPLE KWANONGOMA

KwaZulu-Natal MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison Mr. Bheki Cele has applauded police on the swift move in apprehending four suspects that are linked in the killing of two people at KwaNongoma following an alleged robbery on Tuesday 09/06/09.

Police further confiscated five illegal firearms during an operation and more arrests are expected. The special operation in arresting the notorious hitmen (Izinkabi) linked to the Nongoma taxi violence is still ongoing and police are following a promising lead.

"Police are leaving no stone unturned in bringing criminals to book, as government we shall do everything in our power to maintain law and order and bring stability in the troublesome areas of the province. For as long as
