MEC BHEKI CELE TO OFFICIATE THE SOD-TURNING CEREMONY AND OPENING OF A MULTI-MILLION BRIDGE

KwaZulu-Natal MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Mr Bheki Cele will officiate the sod-turning of Tulwane road and opening of a Pedestrian bridge at Nkandla. The event will start at **9am at eTholamnyama High School** on **Tuesday (03/02/2009)**.
