MEC MCHUNU TO ATTEND IFP COURT CASE

KwaZulu-Natal MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison Mr. Willies Mchunu will be attending the IFP court case held at the Pietermaritzburg High Court. This comes after an interdict put by Ms Zanele Magwaza-Msibi to force the IFP to go for the national conference. The MEC will be going there to ensure the safety and stability of all citizens who will be attending the court case. It has come to the attention of the department that some IFP members have been mobilizing to go and attend the hearing. The MEC will be there to ensure that any conflict that might arise between the alleged factions in the party is avoided.

MEC Mchunu said: "As a custodian of safety in the province I will personally be attending the court hearing. Such is done to ensure that all citizens who will be attending this hearing are safe. We have deployed our police force accordingly. It is our mandate to ensure that all citizens of the province are safe regardless of their standing in society. We urge all members of the IFP and whoever will be attending the hearing to behave in an orderly manner. Those who are found on the wrong side of the law will be dealt with accordingly."
