MEC MCHUNU CONDEMNS THE KILLING OF INDUNA AT FOLWENI

MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison Mr. Willies Mchunu condemns the shooting

and killing of Folweni iNduna yesterday (09/10/11) morning.

Preliminary reports reveal that Walter Makhanya (70) was shot dead at his home in

Kwankonka, Folweni. It is alleged that three attackers broke into house at about 7am, shot him

and ran away. Makhanya died on the scene. Mchunu also commends good work by the police

in re-acting swiftly in apprehending the suspects. Three men were arrested at KwaMakhutha in

possession of a 9mm gun. A case of murder has been opened and the gun has been taken for

ballistic testing.

"We commend a swift reaction from the police we also welcome the co-operation from

the community. At this stage we do not want to draw any conclusion on the motive of the

killing. We are satisfied that police have made an arrest; therefore we hope investigators

will leave no stone unturned in this matter. I appeal to the community of Folweni to rise

and work with the police in fighting and defeating crime in the area. I also wish to send

my condolences to the Makhanya family," said Mchunu
