### **MEC MCHUNU COMMENDS POLICE FOR SUCCESSFULLY APPREHENDING SUSPECT AT MANDINI**

KZN MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison Mr Willies Mchunu has commended police for successfully apprehending suspect at Ndulinde area near Mandeni yesterday.

Reports reveal that, On Sunday, 23 October 2011 at 11:00, Nyoni SAPS members in the North Coast, were doing their normal patrols at Ndulinde area near Mandeni when they spotted a suspicious-looking White VW Golf vehicle with three occupants.

The vehicle was circulated and came as a stolen vehicle at KwaDukuza area. The members tried to stop the said vehicle but it sped off.

The police gave chase and the suspects stopped their vehicle and allegedly shot at the members of the police. The police returned fire, fatally wounding one suspect Sibusiso Mwandla (25) and a second suspect was arrested. The third suspect managed to escape and is still at large. The arrested suspect was charged with attempted murder and possession of a stolen vehicle. He appeared in the Nyoni Magistrates' Court today, 24 Monday 2011.
