### **MEC MCHUNU TO ATTEND A MEMORIAL SERVICE OF THE TEN ROAD VICTIMS IN MTUBATUBA**

KZN MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Mr. Willies Mchunu will attend the Memorial service of 10 people who died on the N2 tomorrow (29 September 2011).

This accident happened last week (19 September, 2011) at about 18h30 when a taxi travelling from Durban to Mtubatuba collided head-on with a bakkie on the N2. Ten people died on the scene and four were critically injured and taken to the Ingwelezane and Richards Bay Hospitals to receive medical attention.

The MEC is expected to be accompanied by the families of the deceased, inter-faith leaders, Community Road Safety Councils, representatives from the Road Accident Fund, the local and district Mayors and members of the community of KwaMsani.
