SYMPOSIUM TO ADDRESS ROAD SAFETY CHALLENGES IN KZN

The KZN MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Mr. Willies Mchunu has taken a bold approach of engaging all role-players with a view to finding solutions in dealing with the challenge of safety in transport. Various stakeholders and speakers have been invited to part-take in the 2 day summit as the MEC shares with all the participants the provincial vision on Road Safety.

The road traffic report of September 2008/09 compiled by the Road Traffic Management Corporation (RTMC) indicates that the KwaZulu-Natal province was overall the worst performing province, recording an increase of 14% in road fatalities. The province was reported to be the biggest contributor to the country not achieving its set target towards the end of the review preview.

This indicates that even though the government has put in place measures through programmes and laws to deal with road safety, there is a need for a critical review of the manner in which traffic safety is being managed. It is evident that a stronger approach is needed to effect a more drastic improvement in road user discipline in order to reduce collisions
