DEP OF TRANSPORT TO HOLD A MEMORIAL SERVICE OF THE N2 ACCIDENT VICTIMS

The Department of Transport in KwaZulu-Natal led by MEC, Mr Willies Mchunu intervened to

assist with the burial of 11 people who died in a gruesome accident that occurred on the N2

near Mandeni, last Thursday (11/08/11).

Reports revealed that the mini bus taxi was travelling from Durban to Ulundi when its left rear

tyre came out. It is alleged that the driver lost control and collided with a truck on the on coming

traffic. Nine people died at the scene while two others died at a later stage including a nine

month old baby.

Both vehicles were taken for a forensic test which is conducted by the RTMC.
