Many people lost their lives and some are now disabled as a result of the taxi violence in KwaDukuza.

The prayer will be attended by families of the taxi violence victims, business community, religious leaders and taxi owners and operators.

This prayer is a joint effort between KwaDukuza and iLembe municipality with the department of Transport in KwaZulu-Natal.

Mchunu is expected to outline his department's intervention in the area following the violent protest by commuters over the increase of taxi fare.

This prayer hopes to promote peace and stability between commuters and taxi operators.
