#### **MEC MCHUNU TO OFFICIATE THE OPENING OF NSONYANE ACCESS ROAD IN NONGOMA**

KZN MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison Mr Willies Mchunu will tomorrow (14/01/11) officiate the opening of Nsonyane road and causeway.

Nsonyane Road and causeway is located in Nongoma local Municipality within Zululand District under Usuthu Traditional Authority under His Majesty the King. The construction for this road came after a need where Nsonyane school teachers and children could not cross the river when heavy rains occurred therefore causing them to miss school. The community in the area also experienced the same problem. Nsonyane Primary School, Falaza high school and Queen Ka Msweli Primary School will benefit from the upgrade of this road.

The total length of the road is 3.2 km off D1820 (L1594) to Nsonyane Primary School. This project is complete and created 40 job opportunities. Two emerging contractors benefited in this project. ***The total cost for this project is R 4,000,000.00.***
