R20 000 FINE FOR DRIVER AT SCOTTBURG MAGISTRATE COURT

KZN MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison Mr Willies Mchunu has commended the Scottburg Magistrate Court in sentencing a driver a fine of R20 000 today(10/09/12).

Sibusiso Moses Mbatha (38) was nabbed doing 204km/h yesterday (09/09/2012) on the N2 Ellingham. He was then taken to the Scottburgh police station and today appeared at the Scottburgh magistrate court where he was fined.

MEC Mchunu has commended the magistrate court for the sentence.

"This is a clear indication that as a department we are working with all structures and the people of KwaZulu-Natal in all their formations in fighting transgressors on the road. I am happy that our magistrates are heading to our plea of giving road transgressors harsh sentences. I welcome the decision taken by the court to fine Mbatha R20 000. This is a warning to other motorists that we are out in full force to ensure that we fight road accidents. As an ideal we must work towards producing a new type of driver in KwaZulu-Natal who respects the rules of law" said Mchunu ENDS
