MCHUNU TO FULFILL BLACK TOP PROMISE TO THE COMMUNITY OF DUMBE

KZN MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Willies Mchunu will tomorrow, Thursday (22 November 2012), fulfill the promise of providing black top road to the community of Dumbe by officiating a sod turning for the upgrade of the remaining gravel section of P271.

P271 is 25.8km in length and is a main road. It will provide the community of Paul Pietersburg access to places of need such as the Hartland Provincial Clinic. The first phase was 11.7 km was upgraded from gravel to black top. The department of Transport will now cover the remaining 14.1km from gravel to blacktop.

This road will cost a staggering amount of R22 million and will create 250 employment opportunities for the community.

Mchunu is expected to be accompanied by the members of the KZN legislature, local mayors, district mayor, traditional leadership and the community of eDumbe.
