## Mchunu condemns rocks throwing on the road

MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Mr. Willies Mchunu strongly condemns the throwing of rocks on the road as it endangers the lives of motorists and other road users.

Mchunu issued a stern warning to all those throwing rocks on the road and vowed that harsh action must be taken against them. **"This trial is very important as we are awaiting the outcomes with a keen interest. The fact that the three boys are on trail must serve as a lesson to all those who are throwing objects on the road. We condemn throwing of rocks on the road because it leads to unnecessary loss of life. We are working very hard with municipalities to put mechanisms and systems to monitor our highways," said Mchunu.**
