KZN DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SAFETY AND LIAISON WILL VISIT DIFFERENT AREAS AS A FORM OF SPENDING THEIR 67 MINUTES WITH THE COMMUNITY.

KWAZULU-Natal Community Safety and Liaison Department will spend its 67 minutes together with the displaced youth that currently hang around at the so-called "Whoonga Park," in Albert Park, Durban.

This event, held in partnership with Izwi Lomzansi Community Radio Station and Ukhozi FM which coincides with Mandela Day, seeks to engage with these youths with a view of encouraging them to stay off the drugs and to warn them of the dangers associated with the abuse of drugs.

It is part of a series of events in which Community Safety and Liaison senior officials and staff members will partake to mark Mandela Day in the province of KwaZulu-Natal.

The Whoonga Park event is part of the Department's programme to warn the communities of the dangers of Whoonga and other drugs. This programme was launched successfully in Chesterville, west of Durban, recently.

Whoonga and other drugs have been found to be the key drivers of crime and criminality and have led to the breakdown of families, loss of morals and decline of morals.

The idea is to engage with this youth and convince them that it is possible to withdraw from using drugs and that there is life after withdrawing from taking drugs

The event will also take a form of infotainment- with live music and speeches taking place simultaneously.

Leading socialites and personalities, some of who had been drug users, will share their experiences with the youth and encourage them to walk away from drugs.
