MCHUNU SHOCKED AND DISMAYED AT THE MERCILESS KILLING OF REVEREND **CIBANE**

KZN MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Mr Willies Mchunu has expressed shock

and dismay at the brutal killing of Reverend Agrippa Cibane of the African Gospel Church at

iLovu, south of Durban.

Reports reveal that on Sunday 16 June 2013 in C section at eLovu, Rev Cibane was shot and

killed moments before he convened his Sunday service.

It is alleged that two unknown assailants opened fire at the Rev Cibane as he was exiting his

vehicle.

MEC Mchunu has welcomed the formation of a task team by the police to investigate this

merciless killing and expressed hope that police would soon bring the perpetrators to book.

The motive of the killing has not been established and no arrests have been made at this stage.

"I condemn this callous killing of Rev Cibane. I, however, have confident that the

task team that has been assembled, will leave no stone unturned in ensuring that the

perpetrators are brought to book. I appeal to the community to come forward and

volunteer any information that may lead to the arrest of suspects. I would like to

send my deepest condolences to the Cibane family and the members of African

Gospel church," said Mchunu.
