

MCHUNU TO LAUNCH NEW PLAN TO HALVE ROAD CARNAGES IN KZN

IN a bid to drastically reduce road carnages in KwaZulu-Natal, MEC for Transport Community Safety and Liaison, Mr Willie Mchunu is expected to announce a new strategy targeting accident hot-spots in the province.

Mchunu will launch this new enforcement strategy tomorrow (18/03/2013) during the early provincial Easter Holiday Road Safety Campaign.

The new strategy will be focusing on doubling efforts in reducing accidents in hot-spots areas thus focusing on ensuring pedestrian and cyclists' safety on provincial road.

Since the launch of Operation Valingozi in 2011, KZN has significantly reduced road related deaths.

Mchunu is going to share with members of the media important statistics on how the province has performed in the past years and share how the province is performing since the beginning of this year.

2013 is dubbed – A year of accelerating activism against road carnages.

This is in line with the United Nations Declaration, calling this a decade, a decade of action against road carnages.
