

MCHUNU TO TABLE KEY PROPOSED SOLUTIONS TO END TAXI VIOLENCE IN KZN

KZN MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Mr Willies Mchunu will tomorrow table key proposed solutions to end on-going taxi violence and killings in the province.

Many parts of the province are experiencing serious tensions and division in the taxi industry which manifest itself through assassinations of prominent operators and instability.

Mchunu will address leaders of the taxi industry in the province on proposed solutions to end taxi violence and ensure peaceful co-existence in the industry.

Mchunu is expected to share government's approach and interventions in areas engulfed by violence and tensions.

Tomorrow, he (MEC Mchunu) will also address the leadership of the taxi industry on how government intends implementing key resolutions of the taxi Indaba which was held last year in Durban.

This will happen as Mchunu is expected to officially open the Annual General Meeting of the South African National Taxi Council (Santaco).

The meeting will also discuss the role of the taxi industry in complying with road safety standards and regulations as Easter Holidays are around the corner.
