MCHUNU CALLS FOR COUNTRIES BORDERING KZN TO FIGHT AGAINST ROAD FATALITIES IN OCTOBER AND BEYOND

The KwaZulu-Natal MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Mr. Willies Mchunu, will attend a multi-disciplinary, cross boarder road block at the South Africa- Swaziland boarder, Golela on Friday, 17 October 2014.

This road block will form part of an effort by the department, after the call made by the MEC during his budget speech where he announced that he would rally all road users and stakeholders to ensure that road safety becomes our collective responsibility. This, he said, will ensure that all stakeholders, including bordering countries, aid in the fight against road fatalities and any criminal activities during the month of October and beyond.

Some of the offences that will be monitored at the road block are drunken driving, vehicle moving offences, seatbelts, driver and vehicle licences, goods overloading, inconsiderate driving ,reckless and negligent driving just to mention a few.
