### 'RAF ON THE ROAD' SETS OFF FOR PIETERMARITZBURG, ON 22 NOVEMBER 2014.

The Road Accident Fund's (RAF) mobile service outreach campaign, 'RAF on the Road', is on route to eMgungundlovu, Pietermaritzburg, on Saturday, 22 November.

The campaign was recently awarded the Minister's Special Award at the inaugural Transport Awards Ceremony in October and also came second during the Centre for Public Service Innovation (CPSI) Awards in the category of Innovative Service Delivery Institutions.

'RAF on the Road', a radical service delivery project, has brought much needed RAF services to over 40 communities countrywide, assisting over 27 000 people and settling more than R591 million's worth of claims. Wider customer access is provided by the RAF's 86 Hospital Service Centres (HSC) and the recently launched Customer Support Centres in four provinces: Limpopo, Northern Cape, North West and the Free State.

The campaign's objective is to meet the faces behind the files, as well as those families who have been adversely affected by motor vehicle accidents.

Eligible community members are encouraged to make use of this opportunity and submit claims directly, thus making a saving on contingency fees. The fund will be making settlement offers, assisting with claims enquiries, recording fraud complaints and providing support to rehabilitating accident survivors.

RAF Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Dr Eugene Watson, said: "RAF's accolades, including the Auditor General's second clean audit award, nominations to the prestigious Batho Pele Awards and making it to the top five Avusa Media Recruitment Awards, is testimony to our efforts to write a new public service legacy. The pursuit of excellence in delivering services to the people is our key performance driver in the RAF."

In addition, road users will be educated about the safe use of roads in light of the envisaged festive season and school holidays.
