MEC MCHUNU TO JOIN FAMILIES OF THE REED DANCE ACCIDENT VICTIMS IN COMMEMORATING 2015 WORLD REMEMBRANCE DAY

The KwaZulu – Natal MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Mr Willies Mchunu, will join the families of the 2013 Reed Dance victims in commemorating the World Remembrance Day, in eShowe on Sunday (15 October 2015).

The commemoration will start with a wreath laying by the families before joining a mass prayer to remember all the victims of road accidents in the province.

Road R66 between Gingundlovu to uLundi and R34 between Nkwalini and eMpangeni has been classified as accident red spot and will see extensive deployment and visibility of traffic personnel ahead of the festive season.

MEC Mchunu will also highlight key strategies and programmes to curb the escalation of road accidents and fatalities during the Festive Season holidays.

MEC Mchunu is expected to be accompanied by all religious leaders, leadership of uThungulu District Municipality, leadership of uMlalazi local municipality and other faith' based organisations.
