### **NDWEDWE TO BENEFIT FROM UPGRADE TO TAR OF MAIN ROAD P712**

The KwaZulu Natal MEC for Department of Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Mr. Willies Mchunu, will officiate the beginning of the upgrade of main road P712 from gravel road to tar tomorrow (Friday, 3 July 2015). This road links Greytown and Stanger and is within the Ndwedwe Local Municipality.

The upgrade stretches 22 kilometres and require a R250 million investment, but will also help to create an estimated 175 direct job opportunities.

It is part of MEC Mchunu's commitments at the department's budget speech earlier this year, which sees the bulk of road developments focusing on mainly underdeveloped, rural areas.

Mchunu will be accompanied by local leadership (District and Local Municipality Mayors, Councillors, and Amakhosi).
