MEC KAUNDA TO MOURN VICTIMS OF GRUESOME ACCIDENT ON THE N2 IN A MASS FUNERAL

The KwaZulu-Natal MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Mr. Mxolisi Kaunda, will join mourners at a mass funeral on Sunday for the six people who died on Sunday (26 June 2016) evening as a result of an accident.

It will be remembered that on Sunday at about 21h00, a bakkie travelling on the N2 collided head-on with truck near the Baobab Intersection, few kilometers away from Mkhuze.

Preliminary reports revealed that one driver failed to stop at an intersection, which resulted to the vehicles colliding head-on.

All the six deceased were occupants in a bakkie which is believed to be from Jozini area and one occupant sustained serious injuries and is getting maximum care at the hospital.

The department has since met with the families of the deceased and have expressed their need for assistance in funeral arrangements.

MEC Kaunda will be joined by the local leadership, members of the interfaith, the families of the deceased as well as the community of uMkhuze.
