PREMIER MCHUNU TOGETHER WITH MEC DHLOMO, SANTACO AND THE INTERFAITH TO LEAD PUBLIC TRANSPORT PROVINCIAL PRAYER IN NEWCASTLE

The KwaZulu-Natal Premier Willies Mchunu together with the Health MEC Dr. Sibongiseni Dhlomo, who is standing in for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Mr. Mxolisi Kaunda, and the KZN SANTACO Leadership, will lead the Provincial Public Transport Prayer in Newcastle on Saturday (29 October 2016).

As part of October Transport Month's ongoing activities, Premier Mchunu, and his delegation will lead a prayer seeking divine intervention in the reduction of road fatalities, and in promotion of peace and stability in the taxi industry. This prayer is a partnership between the public transport industry (which also includes buses and metered taxis) and government, and will also set the tone for the forthcoming Safety Month (November) and the Festive Season (December), by sensitising road users and the broader public on the importance of safety.
