## MEC NTULI TO ATTEND THE MEMORIAL SERVICE OF SEVEN PEOPLE WHO DIED IN A HORRIFIC CRASH IN KWAXIMBA - CATO RIDGE

The KwaZulu-Natal MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Mr Bheki Ntuli, will tomorrow (26 September 2019) attend the memorial service of seven people who died in a horrendous vehicle in KwaXimba, outside Durban.

Reports reveal that the driver of an articulated horse and trailer transporting two concrete rollers lost control and crashed into two light delivery vehicles which were travelling on the opposite direction resulting in a fatal crash leaving seven people (between the ages of 26 and 36) dead. The accident occurred on Magaso road on Friday (20 September 2019) and the Department has since instituted a forensic investigation.

The Department of Transport together with the Road Accident Fund will also assist the bereaved families with the necessary burial arrangements and psychological assistance.
