MEC KAUNDA LEADS KZN POLITICAL PARTIES TO VRYHEID.

THE KwaZulu-Natal MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Mxolisi Kaunda, will tomorrow lead KZN political parties to Vryheid with the intention of resolving political tensions in the area.

Kaunda will convene a five aside meeting between the ANC and IFP in Abaqulusi Municipality in Vryheid to diffuse tensions in the area. Last week, four people were injured after community members organised a protests march complaining about service delivery in the municipality. A scuffle between members of the IFP and protesters broke out which resulted in people being shot and assaulted. Two IFP councillors were arrested and charged for attempted murder and assault.
