## MEC KAUNDA TO ATTEND THE MASS FUNERAL OF SIX PEOPLE WHO PERISHED ON MAIN ROAD P240 DURING EASTER HOLIDAYS

The KwaZulu-Natal MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison Mr Mxolisi Kaunda will on Sunday (28 April 2019), attend the mass funeral of six people who perished on a road crash on P240 at Umkhunyana area at Umlalazi on Easter Friday (19 April 2019).

Reports reveal that the driver of the LDV Isuzu lost control of the vehicle after experiencing brake failure, crashed into guard rails and proceeded down the hill. The vehicle was transporting people from Eshowe to Empangeni for Umembeso. The passengers were thrown out of the vehicle. Six passengers were confirmed dead on the scene while other five were transported to nearby hospitals after sustaining injuries where one of them died later.
