## MEC KHOZA AND MEC NKONYENI TO MEET BEREAVED FAMILIES TO ROLL OUT GOVERNMENT INTERVENTIONS IN INANDA

KwaZulu-Natal MEC for Social Development, Mrs Nonhlanhla Khoza, together with her counterpart, Transport, Community Safety and Liaison MEC, Mrs Neliswa "Peggy" Nkonyeni and Member of Provincial Legislature, Bishop Vusi Dube, will this afternoon meet with the bereaved families of victims of Phoenix killings.

The families are still battling to come into terms with their loss after their loved ones were brutally attacked and murdered in Phoenix.

The two MECs will announce government interventions, including the team of social workers that has to provide psychosocial support to the bereaved families in Inanda areas and KwaMashu.
