KZN PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT'S OPERATION SUKUMA SAKHE SEEKS TO ACCELERATE SERVICE DELIVERY AND CHANGE LIVES

The KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Government led by Premier Sihle Zikalala is on a mission to improve service delivery, access to public services and revive moral regeneration in order to build safer communities.

Premier Zikalala and all the Members of the Executive Council, together with the Deputy Minister for Health Dr Sibongiseni Dhlomo, Deputy Minister for Finance David Masondo and ILembe District Municipality mayors, will on Wednesday, 30 March 2022, hold the Cabinet Operation Sukuma Sakhe programme in Maphumulo Local Municipality.
