MEC NKONYENI WELCOMES ARREST OF SPEEDING ROAD MOTORISTS

KZN MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Ms Peggy Nkonyeni has welcomed an arrest of a driver who was caught speeding excessively yesterday (6 March 2022).

Preliminary reports have revealed that a 37-year-old male who was riding a motor cycle was caught and apprehended by the members of the Road Traffic Inspectorate (RTI) while driving at 196km/h.

He was charged with reckless and negligent driving. He was then taken to Alexandra police station and later released on R3500 bail.

"We pleased with the efforts of our law enforcement officers for arresting the offender, this means that they are always vigilant for any road transgressors. This is testimony to the fact that our enforcement is not seasonal but 365 days a year. We caution all road users to adhere to the prescribed speed limit," said Nkonyeni.
