MEC NKONYENI TO VISIT FLOOD DAMAGED INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS IN ILEMBE DISTRICT

Following the devastating floods that hit many parts of the province, the KwaZulu-Natal MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Ms Neliswa Peggy Nkonyeni, will tomorrow (Wednesday, 12 January 2022) conduct inspections of the most affected and damaged road infrastructure.

MEC Nkonyeni will visit iLembe District, which is one of the most affected areas, particularly eNdwedwe and KwaMaphumulo. Most roads and bridges have been washed away, resulting in total closure and limited access.

In some instances, community members lost their lives trying to cross the low-level structures during the floods. Some of these incidents have gone viral on social media.
