PREMIER ZIKALALA MONITORS PROGRESS ON THE RECONSTRUCTION OF INFRASTRUCTURE DAMAGED BY FLOODS IN KZN

KwaZulu-Natal Premier Sihle Zikalala will on Friday, 29 April 2022, monitor the progress on the ongoing reconstruction and rehabilitation of infrastructure damaged by floods in the province and lead the clean-up campaign in some of the hardest hit areas.

Premier Zikalala will be accompanied by the MEC of Transport, Community Safety and Liaison Neliswa Peggy Nkonyeni and eThekwini Mayor Councilor, Mxolisi Kaunda.

The Premier will start with monitoring progress on the rehabilitation of the N2 northbound between Ilfracombe and Umgababa after sections of the road collapsed due to the floods.

There after the Premier will visit the Durban South Water Aqueduct infrastructure in Umlazi to monitor rehabilitation work underway that is intended to restore water in the Durban South areas.

Lastly, the Premier will lead a massive clean-up campaign along Edwin Swales and the Rossburgh Driver Licence Testing Centre (DLTC) that was damaged in the recent floods.

After the clean-up, Premier Zikalala will update the media at the Rossburgh DLTC on the progress following the KwaZulu-Natal flood disasters following last night's Executive Council meeting.
