PREMIER DUBE-NCUBE UNVEILS 55 TRUCKS TO IMPROVE POTHOLE REPAIR IN THE PROVINCE AS PART OF THE OCTOBER TRANSPORT MONTH CAMPAIGN

KwaZulu-Natal Premier Nomusa Dube-Ncube will launch the 2023 October Transport Month campaign by unveiling 55 new trucks which will be deployed to improve the turnaround time in addressing pothole patching in the province.

These trucks, which are fitted with equipment, will be distributed to all Department of Transport's District Offices.

The procurement of these trucks is part of the commitment by the Premier in her State of the Province Address, where she committed government to paying attention to addressing and improving the condition of the provincial road network.

As part of the roll-out of S'thesha Waya Waya, Premier Dube-Ncube, accompanied by the MEC for Transport, Community Safety and Liaison, Sipho Hlomuka and MEC for Social Development, Ms Nonhlanhla Khoza, will also issue out appointment letters to more than 270 road worker and engineering employees.

This year's October Transport Month Campaign is being rolled out under the theme: Siyakha – Building better infrastructure to grow South Africa together!

The Provincial launch will integrate various aspects, including law enforcement.
