KZN PREMIER NOMUSA DUBE-NCUBE TO HONOUR FIRST SOPA COMMITMENTS BY AWARDING 4000 UNEMPLOYED BENEFICARIES LEARNERS' AND DRIVERS' LICENCE SUPPORT
