- Visiting a learner who had her leg amputated after a bus accident in Vryheid yesterday afternoon.
- Months ago she lost her mother. And her father also died. Her name is Xoliswa Mthethwa from Zululand District Municipality. She was rushed to Greys yesterday due to complications.
- We will also comfort Ms Bongiwe Hadebe, the victim of road accident that took place between Mooi River and Greytown on R622. This accident resulted in the death of 12 people including foreign nationals from Lesotho.

- I will also proceed to inspect White Toyota Hilux Reg No. NP 241 354. It was towed by Heaven D to Estcourt.
- In addition, I will inspect construction of road P19 to ensure the safety of commuters. This forms part of our commitment to strengthen the public Transport system through the construction of roads throughout the corners of KZN.
