We will proceed to other houses and also inspect the reconstruction of Nhlungwane Bridge.

The bridge was washed away by the devastating floods in April 2022. We are now preparing for floods during summer.

Sadly, one motorist died tragically after driving over the damaged bridge and plunging into the ditch.

There are many families who have been waiting for title deeds since 1994.

As the department, we are radically changing the human settlement landscape by accelerating the title-deeds handing over process.

We want to restore the dignity of a mother or a father who, because of policies of the past, remains excluded from property ownership and management processes.
