Midway Weighbridge, N3: The RTI Team in Midway Weighbridge has just impounded 17 trucks with fake discs and fake operating permits.

As learners return to school and workers go back to work, we want to ensure their safety.

We are rolling out #NenzaniLaEzweni Operation and focusing on trucks along the N3, N2 and other routes.

Flowing from above we wish to announce that the RTI, a team from Operation Shanelia Unit and Public Transport Enforcement Unit have joined forces to strengthen #NenzaniLaEzweni Operation.

They will have no mercy throughout the year.

They will also be focusing on the owners of these trucks. We want to ensure their successful prosecution.

Using fake discs and fake permits for trucks is not just a white collar crime but an intention to commit murder.

Importantly, we offer to continue to work with All Truck Drivers Forum and Allied South Africa (ATDF-ASA) and other industry role-players to root out rogue elements within the logistics industry.
