PROVINCIAL TRANSPORT MANAGEMENT (PTM) CIRCULAR NO 10 OF 2006: REVIEW OF THE OFFICIAL VEHICLE POLICY FOR POLITICAL OFFICE BEARERS (POB's)

1. At the April 2006 meeting of the Co-ordinating Committee for Government Motor Transport (CCGMT), it was reported that the Auditor-General's office had requested the National Department of Transport to review the policy for providing vehicles to Political Office Bearers. It was necessary to review Options three and four to bring them in line with the Ministerial Handbook. The options are enclosed herewith as Annexure 1 for your ease of reference.
2. In their report back at the June 2006 meeting of the CCGMT, the National Department of Transport advised that National Treasury had submitted a memorandum to Cabinet stating that the full month lease option should not have been allowed or included in the policy as it constitutes a financial lease. It was also mentioned that option I had been removed and the National Department of Transport was requested to determine why the option was removed.
3. Further, all new orders for vehicles will need to be signed by the National Department of Transport before the vehicle can be ordered off the POB tender.
4. All POB vehicles that were insured via Glenrand MIB will move over to Mmela Financial Service as and when the insurance period expires.
5. In reviewing the official vehicle policy for Political Office Bearers (POB's), the Provinces were requested at the June 2006 CCGMT meeting, to determine the options currently being utilised by the POB's within the Province, or in other words the preferred option of choice, so as not to prejudice our Ministers.
6. You are therefore requested to obtain this information and submit such to this office for the attention of Mrs G Orsmond on e-mail address Geraldine.orsmond@kzntransport.gov.za or on the fax number stated herebelow, **by no later than 31 July 2006.**
