### TO ALL HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS AND ACCOUNTING OFFICERS

- (I) AMENDMENT NO 4 OF 2002 OF THE ANNEXURE TO TRANSPORT CIRCULAR NO 1 OF 1977 (TRANSPORT HANDBOOK ON TARIFFS FOR THE USE OF MOTOR TRANSPORT), AS AMENDED; AND
