

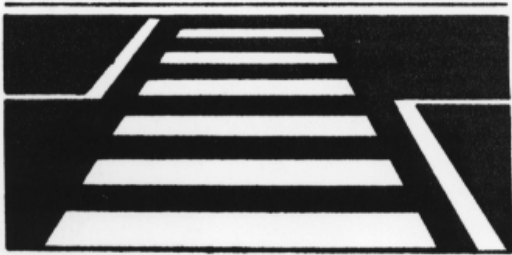
PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS

A pedestrian should always cross at a safe place. Pedestrian crossings, robots and scholar patrols are safer. Pedestrians may only cross when the robot is green. Sometimes there are two special lights, each shaped like a man. These are for pedestrians. The top one is red and the bottom one green. The red one means no-one may cross and the green one everyone may cross. Always keep looking for cars while crossing.

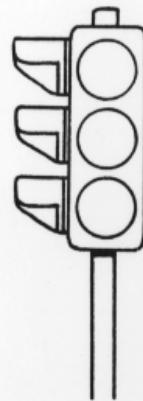
Where there is no special crossing for pedestrians be extra careful. Stop at the kerb first. Look to the right. (These cars pass closest to you.) Look to the left. (These cars will be on the other side of the road.) Look to the right again. (A car may have come in the meantime.) If there are no cars coming walk straight across. Keep looking for cars while you cross.

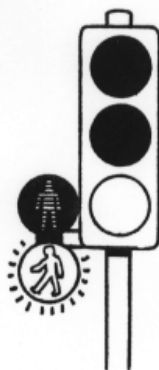
In towns and cities there are special places to cross the street.



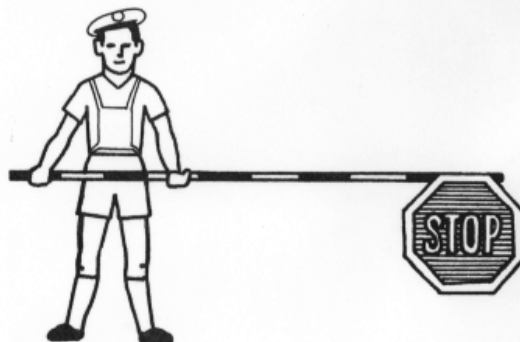
