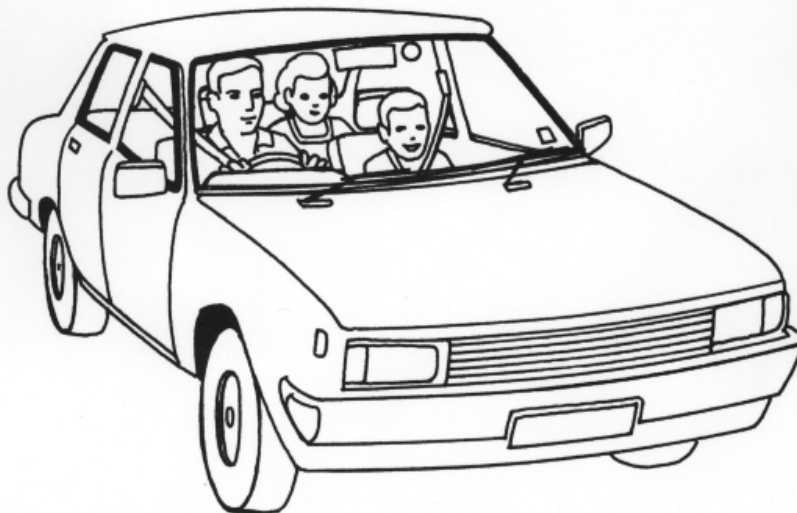
They get to town and father parks the car. They get out onto the pavement. If they get out on the other side, they will be on the street. This is very dangerous because cars go past and can run them over.
