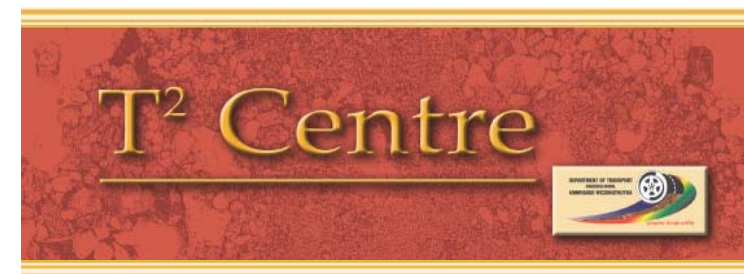

## Background

HIV/AIDS epidemic raises massive challenges for all stakeholders in the South African economy, and will have unavoidable social, ethical and economic consequences. The most effective way in overcoming the spread of this disease is to change human behaviour. Education is still an important tool to improve knowledge on how to prevent the spread of the epidemic.

The T2 Training Centre has ensured that it is essential to transfer knowledge on HIV / AIDS for all its employees by providing AIDS awareness workshops which are conducted in depots and regional offices. The course normally takes about 4-5 hours. These courses are conducted both in English and Zulu.

## Objectives

The objectives of the course are:

- To empower our staff with knowledge by providing information about HIV/AIDS
- To teach the employees how to treat an HIV/AIDS infected employee
- To ensure that the employees know their right related to HIV/AIDS.
- To educate employees of STI's (Sexual Transmitted Infections)
- To curb the spread of HIV/AIDS within the department employees and to promote health and safe lives.
- To teach employees how to live with AIDS.
- To promote a healthy way of living.

## Target audience

KwaZulu Natal Department of Transport staff throughout the province.

Courses can be arranged with the contact people and can be conducted on site or at the Kwazulu-Natal Department of Transport's T2 Training Centre.
