1. PROJECT SPECIFICATION

2.2. PART A: GENERAL

2.2.1. MISCELLANEOUS

All drilling is to be carried out in accordance with the **Standard Specifications for Subsurface Investigations, SANRAL, 2010**.

This specification can be downloaded from: http://www.nra.co.za/content/2010 COTO Spec 12 July 2010.pdf.

It is expected that the successful bidder shall have a copy of this document available.

The Standard Specifications have been written to cover all phases of work normally required for geotechnical investigations and they may therefore cover items not applicable to this contract. These Project Specifications are intended to supplement the Standard Specifications.

The Engineer and Employer will be the KZN Department of Transport, Government of the Republic of South Africa.

2.2.2. GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT AND SITE

The drilling investigations are required for the construction of Mvunyana River Bridge near P16 – 4 km 26, Mondlo, KwaZulu-Natal. Annexure A contains a locality plan.

The six (6 No.) drilling sites are indicated on the Borehole Layout Plan in Annexure B.

2.2.3. GEOLOGY

No information about the geology is known at this stage

2.2.4. NATURE AND EXTENT OF INVESTIGATIONS

The work required shall comprise the drilling of approximately ${}^6_{}N^{}_{}^{}$ rotary cored boreholes of NWD4 or TNW size, at each of the proposed positions. Depths will be as directed by the Engineer, but will generally vary between about 10m and 17m. Boreholes will be drilled vertically and Standard Penetration Tests (SPT's) will be required in all soft materials at 1,0m intervals. All boreholes will be required to extend at least 3m to 4m into weathered rock as determined by the Engineer.

The positions of the boreholes are indicated on the layout plan in Annexure B and will be set out, demarcated and levelled by a Surveyor.

2.2.5. PROGRAMME

It is anticipated that the contract will be awarded at the beginning of August 2019. Establishment on site will be required within 5N^o working days of the date of the letter of instruction to proceed. The work shall be completed within 4N^o weeks of the handover of the site by the Engineer. The Contractor will need to establish two drilling rigs on site in order to meet the drilling programme.

A penalty of R3000-00 per working day will be applicable if the work is not completed within the specified time should the reasons be attributable to poor performance by the Contractor, or an incorrect assessment of drilling conditions.

2.2.6. ACCESS

With reference to Annexure B (Borehole layout plan), access to the borehole positions may require the clearing of shrubs and grass.

2.2.7. WATER

The Contractor is to make his own arrangements for obtaining water. The Contractor's quoted rates shall be deemed to include all costs associated with procuring and transporting water.

2.2.8. CONTRACTORS CAMP AND WORKS AREA

The Contractor will be required to make his own arrangements with regard to work areas. Bidders are to make their own assessment of the security situation and make allowance in their establishment rates for the provision of security measures/guards if considered necessary.

2.2.9. TRANSPORTATION AND PERMANENT STORAGE OF CORE BOXES

On completion of the work, the Contractor will be required to transport the core boxes to the KZN Department of Transport. During the contract the contractor will be responsible for the temporary storage of the cores and his liability for the cores will only cease once they have been satisfactorily handed over into permanent storage.

2.2.10. ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS

The Contractors attention is drawn to the requirements of Section 41 of the Standard Specifications.

2.2.11. VARIATIONS IN SCHEDULED QUANTITIES

Bidders are to note that due to the nature of the investigation, significant positive or negative variations in quantities could occur. No re-negotiation of rates will be entertained in the event of such variations.

2.2.12. INSURANCE

The Contractor shall take out insurance policies, which are adequate to cover all his insurable obligations under the Contract and keep them in force for the duration of the Contract. If called upon to do so, the Contractor shall provide proof that adequate insurances are in force.


2.2.13. HEALTH AND SAFETY
