PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS

1. PROJECT BACKGROUND

The KZN Department of Transport is managing the design of the Mvunyana River Bridge. An Environmental Consultant must be appointed to undertake the necessary EIA processes for this project.

Mvunyana River Crossing is situated near Vryheid on the Mvunyana River, within the Abaqulusi local municipality. The proposed structure is located near the intersection of D1303 and km 26 of P16-4 near Mhlungwana.

2. PROJECT SCOPE

The proposed upgrade comprises the construction of a 75m long vehicular bridge over the Mvunyane River near Vryheid under the Abaqulusi Local Municipality. The abutments on the eastern side cut into a slope and the abutments on the west side of the river are in fill. The river flow is very flat and wide. The bridge crossing provides access to the communities of Ngongweni and Mhlulngwana.

The environmental investigations should include all aspects of the affected environment, i.e. social, environmental and economic.

3. PROPOSED APPROACH AND METHODOLOGY

Following is the proposed approach and methodology to be followed.

a. BASELINE STUDIES AND CONFIRMATION OF BRIEF

Baseline studies will be conducted to identify and investigate sensitive and possible problematic areas, associated 'listed activities' and alternatives. The following should form part of the baseline studies:

- Site Visit
- Confirmation of overall Environmental Status
- Preliminary Identification of Interested and Affected Parties.

b. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

An application must be lodged with the competent authority on the prescribed form and will contain a declaration of interest of the Environmental Assessment Practitioner as well as documentation as required by DAEA&RD.

4. CONDUCTING THE BASIC ASSESSMENT

a. Public Participation Process

The public participation process will be conducted, in isiZulu (primary language medium) and English.

The following tasks must be undertaken:

- Identify all I&AP's and key stakeholders as well as compilation of a register.
- Notify all relevant organs of state.
- Compile and distribute a Background Information Document.
- Obtain the landowner's consent.
- Placement of site notices at the proposed and alternative sites.
- Inform key stakeholders of the proposed development through the distribution of a Background Information Document (BID).

- Advertise the proposed project in one local and one provincial/national newspaper.
- Procure suitable venues to conduct two public meetings (open days), providing translators and compilation & distributing minutes.
- Ensure that all I&APs have access to the draft Basic Assessment Report and that comments from I&APs are received within the specified timeframes.
- Analysis of public participation findings.
- Update and finalize the Basic Assessment Report in accordance with the comments received.
- Advertise the environmental authorization decision for public comment (appeal period).

- Commissioning of specialist studies in support of the Basic Assessment investigation
- Concerns of and responses to I&AP's (Regulation 56)
- Submit an application for water use license.
- Development of borrow pits for construction materials.

5. SUBMISSION OF BASIC ASSESSMENT REPORT

The Basic Assessment Report and any required supporting documentation must be compiled and submitted to the client for review before final submission. The proposed mitigation measures and recommendations for potential environmental impacts must be contained within the Environmental Management Plan (EMP) that would be attached as an appendix to the Basic Assessment Report. The plan must outline roles and responsibilities; including the steps to be taken by the role players should any environmental issue arise during the project.
