The Province of KwaZulu-Natal, Department of Transport, invites tenders from contractors, experienced in roadworks, for the Provision of Routine and Safety Maintenance on Various Roads within the Lotheni Zone – Vulindlela Office. This project is in the province of KwaZulu-Natal in the local municipality of Impendle. The duration of the project is 24 months.
