The Province of KwaZulu-Natal, Department of Transport, invites tenders from contractors, experienced in roadworks, for the PROVISION OF ROUTINE AND SAFETY MAINTENANCE ON VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN THE NOTTINGHAM ZONE - VULINDLELA AREA OFFICE. This project is in the province of KwaZulu-Natal in the district municipality of KZ223 UMgungundlovu. The duration of the project is 24 months.

Only tenderers that satisfy the eligibility criteria stipulated in clause C.2.1 of the Tender Data are eligible to have their tenders considered.

Tenders must have a minimum CIDB contractor grading designation of 8CE or higher.

The successful tenderer must subcontract a minimum of 30% of the value of the Constructions Works to Targeted Enterprises through Contract Participation Goals (CPG) for a bidder that is BEE Level 1 EME or QSE that is more than 51% owned by black person(s).

Tenderers shall be required to demonstrate that they will have in their employ during the contract period the necessary personnel satisfying the requirements of the Scope of Work for labor-enhanced competencies for management and supervisory personnel.

Any tenderer that fails to meet the Prequalifying Criteria/ Local Production and Content/ Subcontracting as condition of tender requirements will be deemed invalid.

Preference points are offered to tenderers who comply with the requirements of PPPFA stipulated in clause C.3.11.1 of the Tender Data.


