The Province of KwaZulu-Natal, Department of Transport, invites tenders from contractors, experienced in regravelling, for the PROVISION OF ROUTINE AND SAFETY MAINTENANCE ON VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN THE SWAYIMANI ZONE - UMSHWATHI AREA OFFICE. This project is in the province of KwaZulu-Natal. The duration of the project is 24 months

Only tenderers that satisfy the eligibility criteria stipulated in clause C.2.1 of the Tender Data are eligible to have their tenders considered.

Tenders must have a minimum CIDB contractor grading designation of 7CE or higher.


